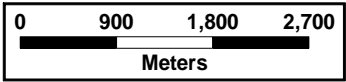
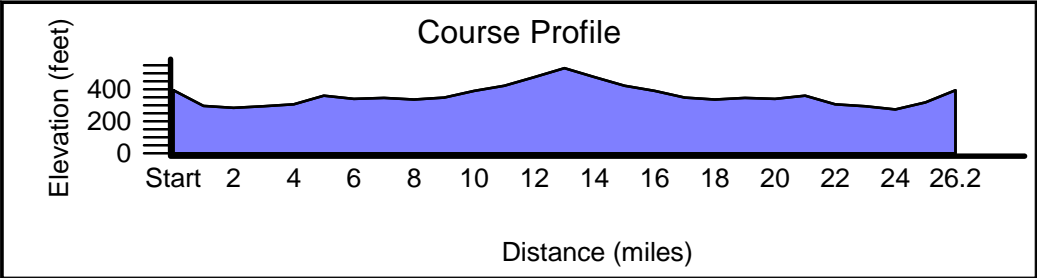


NORTHERN CENTRAL RAIL TRAIL MARATHON

The 26.2 mile certified out and back course starts at Sparks Elementary School and travels through rural and beautiful northern Baltimore County along the Northern Central Railroad Trail. The NCR Marathon course begins with 2 miles of gently rolling roads before accessing the basically flat NCR Trail. Once on the trail, runners will travel 12 miles north on a dirt and crushed stone surface before turning around for the 12-mile slight downgrade back to the finish. The finish line will be at Sparks Elementary School.

The Northern Central Rail Trail is part of the "Rails To Trail" Program. Water and Aid stations will be located throughout the course. Parking is very limited along the trail.

Please note that the trail is open to casual runners, horseback riders and bikers during our event. Please be gracious to all.
